#### **Various Other Methods Available For Cashless Recharge of Smart Card**

- 1. WEB or Online:** -Smart card can also be recharged through WEB or online by using Credit/Debit/Cash Card or online payment (**[www.dmrsmartcard.com](http://www.dmrsmartcard.com)**) Smart Card recharged through this method is to be validated by showing it at Ticket Reader cum AVMs available at Metro stations.
- 2. E-wallets like Paytm:** - Smart Card can be recharged using Paytm. Validation of Smart Card after recharging is required to be done at TR cum AVMs
- 3. POS (Point of Sale Machine):** - Smart Card can be recharged through POS machines using Credit/Debit Card at Metro stations.
- 4. Ticket Vending Machines (TVMs):** These are available at all Metro stations
